

1ST INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF INTELLIGENCES AND TALENTS



The organizing committee is inviting the academic community to present their proposals for the **1st International Congress of Intelligences and talents** to be held in **Medellín – Colombia** on October the 12th, 13th and 14th of 2016.

Authors will be allowed to send proposals for the presentation of works tied to the objectives and the topic of the congress, including original scientific articles regarding the new perspectives about the intelligences and the talent in the childhood, solutions and applications in the classroom, such as intervention programs or meaningful experiences in the pedagogical field.

The congress is inviting the participation in the following formats:

1. Scientific or academic articles.
2. Workshops: they permit the acquisition of competences and knowledge through methodologies combining theory and practice.
3. Meaningful experiences.

Guidelines and presentation model.

For the presentation of all the proposals, at least an author or somebody in charge of the work must register as participant.

1. Types of works to be presented:

a) Academic or scientific articles: works with partial or final results of investigation related to the topics of the congress. These articles must have



a maximum length of 15 pages. The authors of the accepted articles will have **45 minutes for their in – person presentation**, and 15 minutes for discussion and attendants’ questions. In some cases these articles might be considered for their revision, meta – analysis or theoretical, ethical and methodological reflections if the academic commission considers that they represent an important contribution regarding the subject of the congress.

- b) **Worksheets: 55 minutes will be available** for the development, and the proposal will be presented in the format available for downloading in the webpage of the congress: www.congreso-inteligencias-y-talentos.com
- c) **Meaningful experiences:** These are also presented in article – format and proofs of the implementation of the experience, such as photographs or other registration means must be attached. Personal information of the participants must be omitted, and in the case of children, images must be edited in order to avoid revealing their identity, or else a parents’ authorization for the use of such material must be attached as well. These proofs will not be published, they will only be used to confirm that the shared experience was implemented; that is to say, that this was not just an undone project. **45 minutes for an in – person presentation** will be available as well as 15 minutes for discussion and attendants’ questions.

2. Fields:

- a) Theoretical advances
- b) Research
- c) Implementation



3. Subjects:

- a) Theoretical frameworks and paradigms on intelligences and talents in the childhood.
- b) Meaningful experiences in the approach of the intelligences and talents in the classroom.
- c) Psychopedagogical accompaniment and / or intervention programs on this matter.
- d) Partial or final research results regarding this matter.

Guide for submitting the papers

- ✓ Articles must be original and they cannot be in a process of revision in any other congress either national or international publication. Texts may be written in either Spanish or English, but it is mandatory that the abstract of the article be written in both languages (maximum 250 words).
- ✓ The presentation of the articles (both the academic ones and the meaningful experiences) must observe the APA style and contain the sections: Introduction, Methods, Results and Discussion.
- ✓ In the text of the article to be evaluated by the Academic commission, information leading to the identification of the authors must not be included (*double blind review*). The names of the authors will appear on the first page, as well as a biographical review on them (maximum 300 words) and their affiliation. On the second page must appear the title and the abstract in English and in Spanish (maximum 250 words), on this page there should not be any reference leading to the identity of the authors.
- ✓ All the proposals of presentations must be sent online through the web page of the congress www.congreso-inteligencias-y-talentos.com or to the email



address inteligenciasytalentos@gmail.com in two files, one in an editable format (.doc; .docx) and another one in pdf.

- ✓ The proposals of presentation will be analyzed by the Academic Commission. In case of approval, authors should send the final version of the text for publishing (adding the recommendations considered by the Academic Commission of the congress if there was any).

Revision process

All accomplished works, submitted within the deadline and complying with the presentation rules will be revised.

Each one of the works will be revised by 2 copy editors, members of the Academic Commission.

After the revision process, the author will be contacted and he / she will be informed on the acceptance or the denial of the submitted work. If approved, authors should accept the suggestions aimed to improvement, which will be related to the style, with clarification or extension on information, and the final version of the work must be submitted within the deadline.

If authors do not accept the recommendations of the copy editors, the Academic Commission would decide whether or not they will integrate these into the congress, although their presentations in the event will still be permitted.

Publication

Publications which are accepted by the Academic Commission will be issued in the minutes of the congress (in digital format or paper, with ISBN)



Submitting process

1st phase (until June 1st of 2016) – Receipt of proposals: read carefully the conditions for submission and verify that the work meets all of these requirements, if not, it might lead to rejection. If any doubt, do not hesitate to ask through the email address:

2nd phase (from June 1st to July 1st of 2016) – Revision of the works: 2 expert copy editors will be assigned to each work and the revision will be done through the *double blind review system*.

3rd phase (from July 1st of 2016 to August 7th of 2016) – submission of definite articles intended for publishing: authors will be notified on the decision made by the Academic Commission regarding the acceptance or rejection of their works. The authors of the accepted works will have one month to make the improvements suggested by the Academic Commission before the publication of their papers.

DELIVERY OF CERTIFICATES

A certificate confirming your participation as a presenter in the congress will be granted.
